



Notebook – Requirements for New Students at the BFH Business School (BYOD)

For your studies at BFH, you are required to bring your own notebook (BYOD – Bring Your Own Device).

To ensure that you can participate in classes and take examinations at BFH without any issues, your device will be used with the **Lernstick** as well as with the **Safe Exam Browser (SEB)** in certain modules/exams. Please take the following points into account when choosing your device.

Lernstick

The Lernstick currently supports the following devices:

Windows Devices:

- The Lernstick is compatible with **the majority of common Windows laptops**.

Apple:

- Macs with **Intel processors** (up to model year 2020)
- Macs with Apple **M1 or M2** chipsets

Not supported:

- Macs with newer Apple chipsets (e.g., **M3, M4, M5** or future versions)
- **iPads** and various **tablets**

Safe Exam Browser (SEB)

- No special hardware requirements are necessary; it is only essential that the operating system operates in a reliable and stable manner.

Conclusion / Recommendation

To ensure you do not encounter any limitations during exams, we recommend consulting the above Lernstick specifications before purchasing a device.
