*This module list is tentative only. Nominated and accepted incoming exchange students shall receive the definitive module list, module descriptions and detailed instructions for submitting their module selection by email approximately two months before the semester begins.*

## Module Selection Guidelines

- **A minimum of 12 ECTS** must be completed within the chosen degree programme.
- Additional credits can be selected freely **from all available Master-level modules**. Bachelor-level modules open to exchange students are also available to Master-level incoming students.
- The **autumn semester** includes both 1st- and 3rd-semester modules. We recommend selecting 1st-semester modules, as most students begin their studies at this point. This typically ensures a smooth start and a cohesive learning experience.
- The spring semester includes modules from the 2nd and 4th semesters. An exchange in the spring semester is possible, but it may be more challenging without the foundational introduction offered in the autumn semester.
- All **module requirements** must be fulfilled as outlined in the respective module descriptions.
- **Overlapping modules are not permitted.**

## Min / Max Credits

Incoming students must enroll in modules totaling a minimum of 12 ECTS and a maximum of 32 ECTS credits.

## Workload

1 ECTS credit equals approximately 30 working hours. This includes contact hours, self-study, project work, and exam preparation. Further information on the ECTS credit system can be found here: [ECTS credit system](#)

## Group Projects

Group projects – including collaborative assignments and presentations – are common at the BFH Business School. If a module includes a group project, attendance on designated dates is mandatory. All group members are expected to contribute equally.

## Exam Period

Final exams will take place on campus between calendar weeks 3–5 (mid January to early February) in the autumn semester and calendar weeks 25–27 (late June to early July) in the spring semester. Whether or not a module includes a final exam during the official examination weeks is specified in the module descriptions. Please note that if you select modules with final exams scheduled in these official exam periods, you must be present in Bern, as on-site attendance is mandatory.
