



Wanted: Hackathon organizers interested in inclusion and diversity

The Hack Integration project aims to foster more diverse and inclusive hackathons, bringing high-skill refugees and migrants to events and using improved tools to form diverse and inclusive teams. To this end, Bern University of Applied Sciences and the University of Zurich are looking for events that are interested in high-skill refugee attendees as well as events that are interested in testing a team suggestion tool.

Recruiting high-skill refugee and migrant attendees is one way to have a more diverse event and potentially help participants. A team suggestion tool encouraging groups with the right skill-mix can help further interdisciplinary collaboration and inclusion. These are new ways to help your event be more diverse, inclusive, and productive!

We are looking for hackathons from all over Switzerland.

- Organisers of open events can register their events in our [→hackfinder tool](#). This is a general participant recruitment tool, which will be highlighted in the high-skill refugee/migrant community.
- Organisers of private corporate hackathon events can allocate a certain number of slots at their event for pre-screened refugee/migrant participants. The effort is small and maybe you will find some hidden talent out there. In addition, you are profiled on our website as a corporate partner!

- All hackathon organizers can join our study testing a team suggestion tool as part of a controlled study. All participating events distribute a link to a short, standardized survey to their participants covering team and event experience. Afterwards you get access to pooled anonymised data from across multiple events which can help you improve your event!
