



English-speaking Modules available for Incoming Exchange Students

Degree Programme: MSc Digital Business Administration

The degree programme MSc Digital Business Administration is taught entirely in English.

The module offer for exchange students in the autumn semester is either the 1st semester package or 3rd semester package. In the spring semester there is one module package on offer. Exchange students are required to select at least two modules from their respective semester in MSc Digital Business Administration. Combining modules between the 1st and 3rd autumn packages is not possible.

Additionally, it is possible to choose modules taught in English or in German from the Bachelor level modules offered to exchange students or from the Msc Business Administration degree programme (for German-speakers).

General Information

Requirements

At Master level, exchange students' applications are reviewed individually and admission is decided by the Head of Degree Programme.

For modules to be selected by the student, module requirements must be met, as laid out in the module descriptions.

Time Table

We do not allow students to take modules that overlap in time. Sometimes the same module is taught in two or more different classes, so you have the possibility to choose the one that best fits your time table.

Limited Spots

Modules have limited spots available, and they will be filled on a first come, first served basis.

Module Changes

Module changes are only possible in the first two semester weeks. Drop-outs need no further explanation. Enrolling into new modules are accepted in exceptional cases, for example in the event of unexpected time table clashes or unmet requirements in another module.

Workload

1 ECTS = 30 working hours. This includes contact lessons, self-study, project work and exam preparation. Further information about the ECTS credit system: https://ec.europa.eu/education/resources-and-tools/european-credit-transfer-and-accumulation-system-ects_en

Min / Max Credits

Each incoming student must enroll into modules with a total of at least 12 ECTS per semester. The maximum amount of credits per semester is 32 ECTS. Note that your home university may have different requirements.

Group Projects

Group projects – group assignments and presentations – are very common at the BFH Business School. If group projects are the form of assessment in a module, attendance is required at designated dates and times. Each student in a group must contribute on an equal basis.

Exam Period

Final exams will take place on campus according to the academic calendar; prepare to be present in Bern for them.
