Checklist

My health and accident insurance meets Swiss requirements:

I have obtained written confirmation of this from my health and accident insurance provider.

If I have private (additional) insurance, I have checked the extent of its cover in Switzerland.

I have checked if I need to exempt from compulsory health insurance within 90 days of my arrival in Switzerland: <http://www.jgk.be.ch> > Prämienverbilligung > Obligatorische Krankenversicherung > Befreiung [web site in German and French only, [information sheet](#) also in English].

My health and accident insurance does not meet Swiss requirements:
